LIVING IN VENICE

Venice stretches across 120 small islands in the Venetian lagoon along the Adriatic Sea in northeast Italy. Living in Venice implies being immersed in a world of stunning art and architecture while being exposed to stimulating teaching and research. It also entails an environmentally conscious lifestyle and endless opportunities for discovering different traditions and cultures, for it has a vibrant international atmosphere.

COSTS OF LIVING

Accommodation Historic centre of Venice:

- Around € 400 per month for a single room, excluding utilities
 - Around € 250 per month for a shared room, excluding utilities
- Mainland Venice:
- Around € 200 per month for a single room, excluding utilities
 - Around € 125 per month for a shared room, excluding utilities

Other living costs • Food: € 50–80 per week

- Public transport: vaporetto/bus tickets cost € 1.50 each or € 25 for a month-long pass
