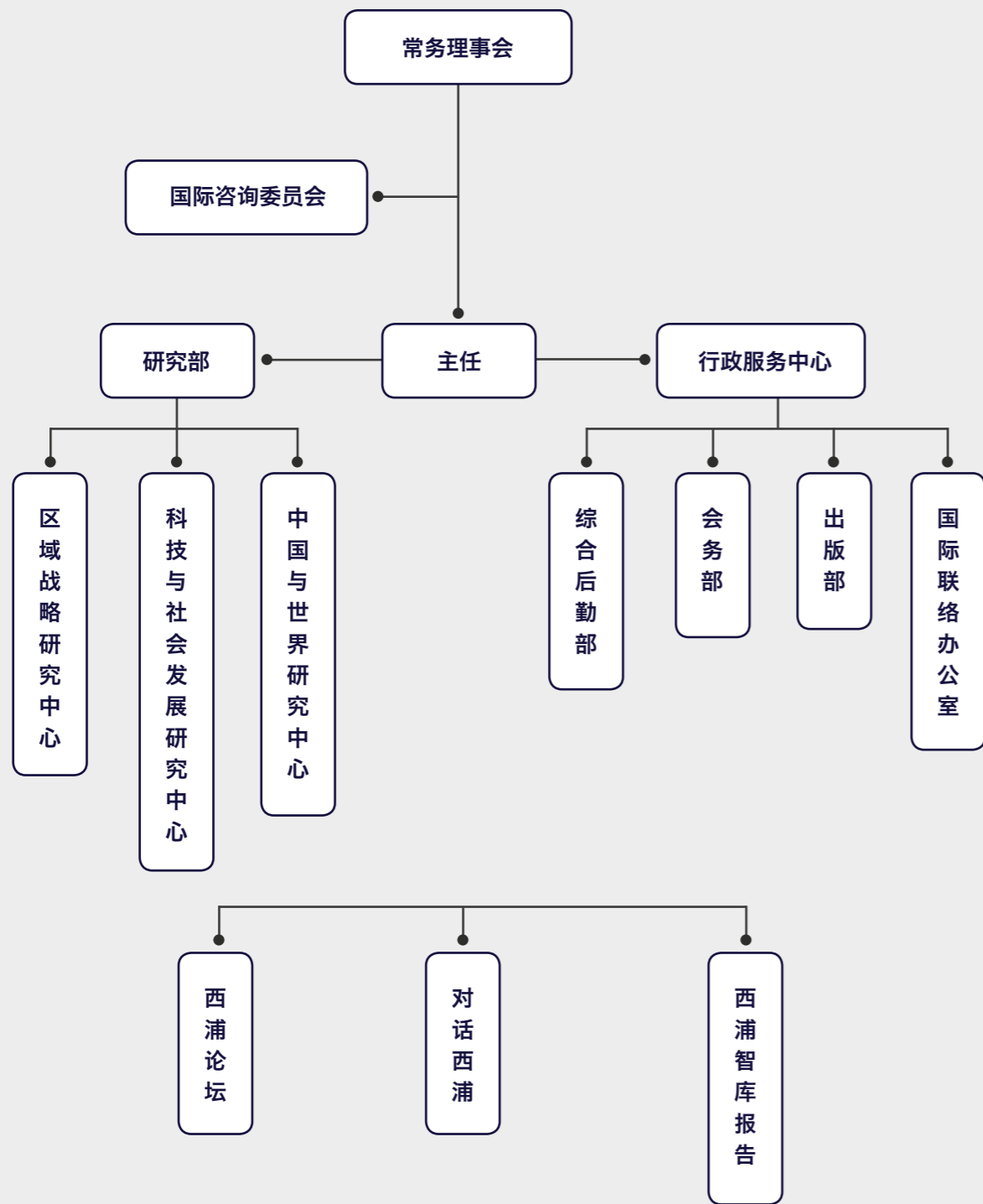

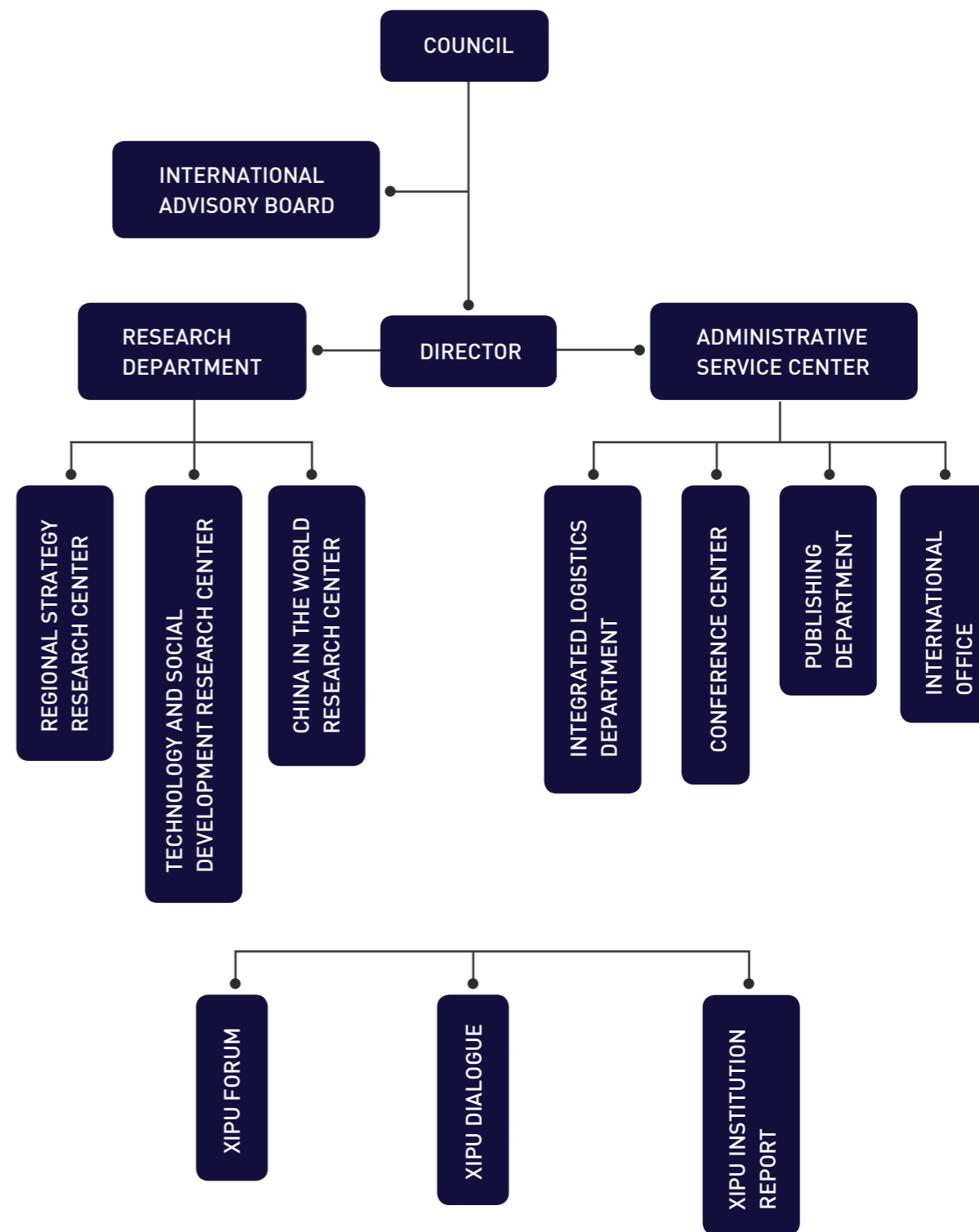

穆拉图·特肖梅博士于2013年10月7日由埃塞俄比亚联邦民主共和国人民代表院和联邦院联合选举就任埃塞俄比亚联邦民主共和国总统。在就任总统前，他于2006年3月至2013年10月担任埃塞俄比亚驻土耳其共和国大使，同时兼任格鲁吉亚共和国、阿塞拜疆共和国、哈萨克斯坦共和国和塔吉克斯坦共和国非常驻大使。

穆拉图·特肖梅博士于2002年10月至2005年10月间担任埃塞俄比亚议会联邦院议长。他是2002年10月10日被选举为埃塞俄比亚议会联邦院（也就是联邦议会的上院）议长，是埃塞俄比亚历史上第二位选举出来的议长。

2001年至2002年，穆拉图·特肖梅博士担任农业部部长。在任期间，他率领埃塞俄比亚代表团出席了2002年8月26日至9月4日在南非约翰内斯堡举行的可持续发展世界首脑峰会、同年6月10日到13日在罗马举行的世界食品峰会、同年2月19日到20日在罗马举行的第二十五届农发基金管理委员会会议、以及同年2月4日到8日在埃及开罗举办的第二十二届粮农组织会议。

穆拉图·特肖梅博士于1995年至2001年还担任过埃塞俄比亚经济发展和合作部副部长，负责埃塞俄比亚双边及多边国际经济合作，并率领埃塞俄比亚代表团参与和发展伙伴之间所有的双边和多边谈判和年度咨询会议。他率领埃塞俄比亚代表团出席了东南非共同市场部长会议全部会，特别是1998年6月在肯尼亚，1999年6月在毛里求斯，2000年6月在埃及举行的峰会。他也是东京非洲发展国际准备会

议中埃塞俄比亚代表团的代表，并于1997年至1998年在东京、达喀尔、哈拉雷、亚的斯亚贝巴召开的预备会议及东京召开的正式峰会的报告起草人。

穆拉图·特肖梅博士，1957年出生于埃塞俄比亚沃尔加省；精通英语、阿姆哈拉语、汉语、奥罗莫语及部分法语；1982年毕业于北京大学，获得政治经济学和哲学学士学位；1988年获得北京大学法学硕士学位，1991年获得法学博士学位。在北京大学攻读博士学位期间，穆拉图·特肖梅博士赴美国就国际关系专业继续学习。并于1990年5月获得弗莱彻法律和外交学院（由哈佛大学和塔夫茨大学共同管理，1988-1990年）法学硕士学位。值得一提的是，在正式进军政坛前，穆拉图·特肖梅博士于1982年至1984年间曾担任德布雷-泽特农业学院和亚的斯亚贝巴大学兽医研究所助理讲师，1988年至1990年间担任弗莱彻法律和外交学院国际关系专业助教。

1991年穆拉图·特肖梅博士毕业回国，进入埃塞俄比亚外交部工作，开始了外交生涯。他很快从参赞晋升为政策制定及培训司司长，于1992年至1994年间出任埃塞俄比亚驻日本大使，及埃塞俄比亚驻泰国、越南、印度尼西亚、澳大利亚和菲律宾大使；1994年至1995年担任埃塞俄比亚驻华大使。

穆拉图博士与Meaza•Abreham女士结为夫妇，并育有一子。穆拉图博士闲暇时间喜欢游泳、足球等活动及欣赏古典音乐。

H.E. Dr Mulatu Teshome Wirtu was elected President of the Federal Democratic Republic of Ethiopia on 7 October 2013 by the joint session of the House of People's Representatives and the House of Federation of the Federal Democratic Republic of Ethiopia.

Prior to his election as the President of the Federal Democratic Republic of Ethiopia, he was Ambassador Extraordinary and Plenipotentiary of the Federal Democratic Republic of Ethiopia to the Republic of Turkey. H.E. Dr Mulatu Teshome Wirtu was simultaneously accredited to the Republic of Georgia, the Republic of Azerbaijan, the Republic of Kazakhstan and to the Republic of Tajikistan as non-resident Ambassador Extraordinary and Plenipotentiary (March 2006 - October 2013). Prior to his post as an Ambassador of Ethiopia to Turkey, he was the Speaker of the House of Federation of the Federal Democratic Republic of Ethiopia (October 2002 - October 2005). H.E. Dr Mulatu Teshome was elected speaker of the House of Federation on 10 October 2002. He is the second speaker in history to be chosen as the Speaker of the House of Federation of the Federal Democratic Republic of Ethiopia, which is the Second Chamber of the Federal Parliament.

H.E. Dr Mulatu Teshome has devoted his entire professional life to working for the Government. Prior to being elected Speaker of the House of Federation, he was Minister of Agriculture (2001-2002). During his tenure as Minister of Agriculture, he was: Head of the Ethiopian Delegation to the World Summit on Sustainable Development (WSSD) in Johannesburg, South Africa, 26 August - 4 September 2002, Alternate Head of the Ethiopian Delegation to the World Food Summit in Rome 10-13 June 2002, Head of the Ethiopian Delegation to the 25th Session of IFAD Governing Council in Rome 19-20 February 2002 and Head of the Ethiopia Delegation to the 22nd FAO Regional Conference for Africa, Cairo, Egypt 4-8 February 2002.

Before his appointment as Minister of Agriculture, Dr Mulatu held the position of Vice Minister (1995-2001) at the Ministry of Economic Development and Cooperation (MEDAC). He was in charge of international economic cooperation both bilateral and multilateral and led the Ethiopian delegation in all bilateral and multilateral negotiations and annual consultation meetings with Ethiopia's development partners since in office at MEDAC in

1995. He led the Ethiopian Delegation to all COMESA Council of Ministers and specifically represented Ethiopia at the summit level in Kenya (June 1998), Mauritius (June 1999) and Egypt (June 2000). He was also Head of the Ethiopian Delegation to all the preparatory meetings of TICAD II and assumed the role of Rapporteur in all of the preparatory meetings in Tokyo (November 1997) Dakar (March 1998), Harare (June 1998), Addis Ababa (September 1998) and finally at the summit in Tokyo (19-21 October 1998).

Before joining the Ministry of Economic Development and Cooperation, Dr Mulatu was in the field of diplomatic service as: Ambassador Extraordinary and Plenipotentiary to the People's Republic of China (1994-1995), Ambassador Extraordinary and Plenipotentiary to Japan (1992-1994) and non-resident Ambassador to Thailand, Vietnam, Indonesia, Australia and the Philippines.

He started his career as a counsellor where he held senior positions as a civil servant at the Ministry of Foreign Affairs in October 1991. Dr Mulatu's professional experience also includes research and teaching. He was a research and teaching assistant in international relations when he was a Master of Arts in Law and Diplomacy student at the Fletcher School of Law and Diplomacy, Tufts University (1988 - 1990). He was assistant lecturer at the Debre-zeit Agricultural College and Veterinary Institute of the Addis Ababa University (1982-1984).

Born in 1957 in Wollega, Ethiopia, Dr Mulatu is fluent in English, Amharic, Chinese, Oromifa and tries a little bit of French. He obtained a BA degree in Political Economy and Philosophy at Peking University in 1982. In 1988 he obtained LLM in International Law and a PhD in 1991 from the same university.

After finishing coursework for his PhD candidacy at Peking University, he went to the United States of America for further studies in International Relations. He was at the Fletcher School of Law and Diplomacy (administered by Harvard and Tufts University 1988 - 1990) where he acquired his MALD degree in May 1990. Dr Mulatu is married to Meaza Abreham with whom he shares a son, Paulus Mulatu. His hobbies include swimming, football, tennis and classical music.

西交利物浦大学执行校长(2008.8.8-), 英国利物浦大学副校长(2008.11.1-), 西安交通大学管理学教授(1992-), 陕西MBA学院常务副院长(1996-); 曾任西安交通大学党委常委、副校长(1998.6-2009.1)、西安交大管理学院院长、西安交大城市学院创立院长(2004-2009)。

1957年生。1982年在陕西机械学院取得物理学学士学位, 1984年在西安交通大学获系统工程硕士学位, 1987年获我国大陆第一个管理工程博士学位, 1993年成为我国管理工程领域最年轻的博士生导师。其后曾多次赴加拿大、美国、新加坡、日本等国及香港、澳门、台湾等地区开展合作研究和讲学。

主要从事战略管理及政策分析、决策与决策支持系统、管理行为与领导理论等领域的研究和教学, 于1987年创立了和谐理论, 并将其扩展成和谐管理理论。近年来, 他以西浦为基地, 大胆进行教育及大学管理的创新, 西浦的成功实践逐步引起社会各界的关注。

已培养硕士、博士生100余名, 研究工作先后获国家教委“优秀青年教师基金”、“跨世纪人才重点跟踪支持基金”、国家自然科学基金会“优秀中青年人才专项基金”、“国家杰出青年基金”“国家优秀创新团队基金”等的支持, 主持和参加各类科研课题60余项, 其中国家攻关、重大、重点项目30余项, 出版学术著作20余部, 在国内外学术期刊发表论文300余篇, 曾获省部级以上科研成果奖10余项, 并获得“做出突出贡献的中国博士学位获得者”、“全国优秀留学回国人员”、“国家级有突出贡献中青年专家”等

荣誉称号, 以及“中国青年科技奖”、“中国青年科学家奖”等综合性奖励。

现兼任教育部工商管理教育指导委员会主任委员、教育部科技委员兼管理学科部常务副主任、国家自然科学基金委员会管理学部咨询委员会委员、中国管理现代化研究会副理事长、中国企业现代化研究会副会长, 江苏省人大代表, 兼任《管理学家》(实践版)(学术版)主编以及多家术期刊编委等。曾任国务院学位委员会工商管理、管理科学与工程学科评议组召集人、中国系统工程学会副理事长、全国MBA教育指导委员会委员等。

Executive President of Xi'an Jiaotong-Liverpool University, Pro-Vice-Chancellor of University of Liverpool, Prof. of Management of Xi'an Jiaotong University, Executive Vice Dean of Shaanxi MBA College, Former Vice President of Xi'an Jiaotong University, Dean of Xi'an Jiaotong University Management School and Xi'an Jiaotong University City College.

Professor Xi was born in 1957. He gained his B.S. in Physics from Xi'an Science and Technology University in 1982, and M.E. in system engineering from Xi'an Jiaotong University in 1984. In 1987 he was awarded the first Doctor degree in management engineering in mainland China and in 1993 he became the youngest supervisor of PhD Candidates in management engineering in China. As a visiting professor, he has conducted joint research projects and discourses in Universities of Canada, America, Singapore and Japan as well as Hong Kong, Macao and Taiwan.

Professor Xi's research and teaching areas cover strategic management and policy analysis, decision-making and decision support system, management behavior and firm theory, etc. He established harmony theory in 1987 and developed it to harmonious management theory.

He has successfully supervised over 100 Masters and PhDs. He has gained supports from Excellent Yong Teacher Fund, Trans-century Talents Emphasis Tracking Support Fund, Excellent Young and Middle Age Experts' Fund of NSFC, National Outstanding Youth Foundation and National Excellent Innovation Team Foundation to host or participate in over 60 various research projects. Among those, over 30 projects were national key projects. As author or co-author, more than 300 academic papers and 20 books have been published. He gained over 10 prizes in provincial or ministerial levels and Chinese Doctors with Distinguished Contributions, National Excellent Returned Scholars, National Young and Middle Age Experts with Distinguished Contributions, and prizes of Science and Technology for Chinese Youth and also of Science and Technology for Chinese

Young Scholars.

Professor Xi is Commissioner and Head of the Application Appraisal Group of the Business Management Science Department of the National Natural Science Foundation of China, Suzhou NPC Delegate, Vice Director General of China Research Society for Modernization of Management, Vice-chairman of China Research Society for Modernization of Enterprise, Member of Jiangsu Municipal People's Congress as well as editor of <GuanLiXueJia> (Practice)(Academic) and a member of Editorial Board of several Chinese academic journals. He was the Convener of the Evaluation Group of Business Administration, Management Science and Engineering Division of the Academic Degree Commission of the State Council, Vice Chairman of Systems Engineering Society of China, Commissioner of the Advisory Committee of National MBA Education of China.

丁忆民博士于2010年8月被任命为西交利物浦大学副校长，主管行政事务。

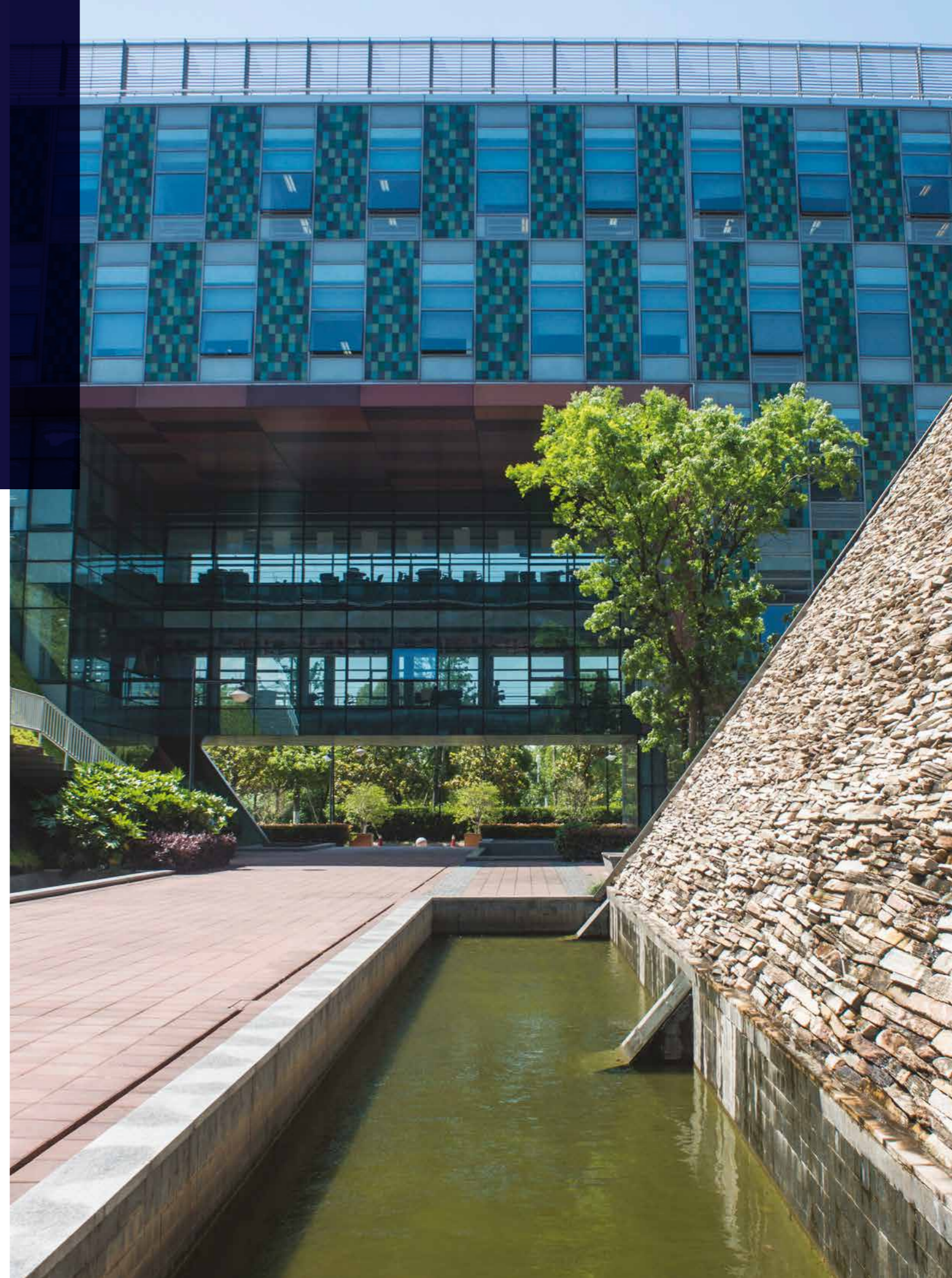
丁忆民博士在财务、人力资源、信息技术、商务、采购、项目管理及企业管理等方面有近20年的资深专业经验。

薄智跃教授是国际著名学者，研究中国精英政治的领军人物，现任西交利物浦大学西浦智库主任、教授。他毕业于北京大学国际政治系，获法学学士和法学硕士学位；并获美国芝加哥大学政治学博士。薄教授是美国德州塔来顿大学首任Joe and Teresa Long Endowed Chair in Social Sciences讲座教授并获美国圣约翰菲舍大学2003-2004年度董事会杰出学者奖并先后担任上海交大访问特聘教授、台湾国立政治大学和国立台湾大学的讲座教授。

他曾在北京大学、美国罗斯福大学、美国芝加哥大学、美国美利坚大学、美国圣约翰菲舍大学、美国德州塔来顿大学、香港中文大学、上海交通大学、台湾政治大学、新加坡国立大学、新西兰维多利亚大学等多所中外著名大学任教，教授国际关系、中国近现代史、中国政治、亚洲政治等课程。薄教授是薄智跃当代中国研究院的创办人兼总裁并担任新西兰当代中国研究中心全国中心主任。

薄教授的研究领域主要是中国政治、两岸关系、中美关系、国际关系理论等，研究方法以统计分析见长。他发表英文论文200多篇，出版著作9本，包括中国精英政治三卷本Chinese Provincial Leaders: Economic Performance and Political Mobility since 1949 (M.E. Sharpe, 2002), China's Elite Politics: Political Transition and Power Balancing (World Scientific, 2007), China's Elite Politics: Governance and Democratization (World Scientific, 2010)。他的最新著作包括 China-US Relations in Global

Perspective (2016) 和 China's Political Dynamics under Xi Jinping (2017)。

薄教授受邀在中外著名大学和研究机构进行了100多场重要学术演讲。这些大学和研究机构包括哈佛大学、牛津大学、哥伦比亚大学、芝加哥大学、西北大学、悉尼大学、澳洲国立大学、柏林自由大学、布拉格查尔斯大学、罗马大学、哥本哈根商学院、汉堡大学、中央研究院、新加坡国立大学、美国国家新闻俱乐部等。同时，薄教授还长期从事国际智库工作，为世界各国领袖、商业精英、外交官员提供高端咨询。

薄智跃教授经常出现在国际媒体上。他是BBC、ABC、CNBC、CCTV、Channel NewsAsia、New York Times、the Financial Times、Washington Post、Reuters、the Guardian、the Times、Bloomberg、新华社、人民日报、Strait Times等国内外媒体的采访对象，曾获“国际媒体关于中国领导更替引用最多的学者”奖。

Professor BO Zhiyue (薄智跃), a leading authority on Chinese elite politics in the world, is Director and Professor of Think Tank at Xi'an Jiaotong-Liverpool University in Suzhou, People's Republic of China.

Professor BO obtained his Bachelor of Law and Master of Law in International Politics from Peking University and Ph.D. in Political Science from the University of Chicago.

He has taught at Peking University, Roosevelt University, the University of Chicago, American University, St. John Fisher College, Tarleton State University, the Chinese University of Hong Kong, the National University of Singapore, and Victoria University of Wellington. He is a recipient of the Trustees' Distinguished Scholar Award at St. John Fisher College and the inaugural holder of the Joe and Theresa Long Endowed Chair in Social Sciences at Tarleton State University. He has also been Visiting Distinguished Professor at Shanghai Jiaotong University in China and Chair Professor at both National Chengchi University and National Taiwan University in Taiwan. He is Founder and President of the Bo Zhiyue China Institute, a consulting firm providing services on China to heads of governments and CEOs of multinational corporations.

His research interests include China's elite politics, Chinese provincial leaders, central-local relations, cross-strait relations, Sino-U.S. relations, international relations theories, and global governance. He has published more than 200 book chapters and articles and nine books, including a trilogy on China's elite politics, Chinese Provincial Leaders: Economic Performance and Political Mobility since 1949 (2002), China's Elite Politics: Political Transition and Power Balancing (2007), and China's Elite Politics: Governance and Democratization (2010). His most recent books include China-US Relations in Global Perspective (2016) (edited) and China's Political Dynamics under Xi Jinping (2017).

Professor BO is a popular public speaker. He has been invited to give major scholarly

presentations at many universities and research institutions around the world. These institutions include Oxford University, Harvard University, Columbia University, the University of Chicago, Northwestern University, University of Sydney, Australian National University, Aarhus University, Free University of Berlin, Charles University in Prague, University of Rome "La Sapienza," Istituto per gli Studi di Politica Internazionale (ISPI), Vrije Universiteit Brussel, University of Leuven, Sciences Po, Copenhagen Business School, Lund University, the Institute for Security and Development Policy in Stockholm, University of Turku, the University of Hamburg, Academia Sinica, National Chengchi University, National Taiwan University, Hong Kong University, Chinese University of Hong Kong, Hong Kong University of Science and Technology, Hong Kong Baptist University, University of Macau, Western Carolina University, Tarleton State University, the National University of Singapore, and the National Press Club of the United States, as well as many universities in China and New Zealand.

He is also a renowned consultant for government agencies and business organizations. He has briefed government leaders and senior diplomats in Singapore, Thailand, Russia, the Netherlands, France, South Korea, Taiwan, China, the European Commission, and New Zealand as well as business leaders in the United States, Australia, Hong Kong, Singapore, and Europe.

Professor BO has been frequently interviewed by international media such as BBC, ABC, CNBC, CCTV, Channel NewsAsia, New York Times, Washington Post, Reuters, the Guardian, the Times, and Bloomberg. He is the winner of the "most quoted by Western media prize" on China's leadership transition.

Adam Przeworski is the Carroll and Milton Professor of Politics and (by courtesy) Economics at New York University. Previously he taught at the University of Chicago, where he was the Martin A. Ryerson Distinguished Service Professor, and held visiting appointments in India, Chile, France, Germany, Spain, and Switzerland. A member of the American Academy of Arts and Sciences since 1991, he is the recipient of the 1985 Socialist Review Book Award, the 1998 Gregory M. Luebbert Article Award, the 2001 Woodrow Wilson Prize, the 2010 Lawrence Longley Award, and the 2010 Johan Skytte Prize. He recently published Democracy and the Limits of Self-Government (New York: Cambridge University Press. 2010).

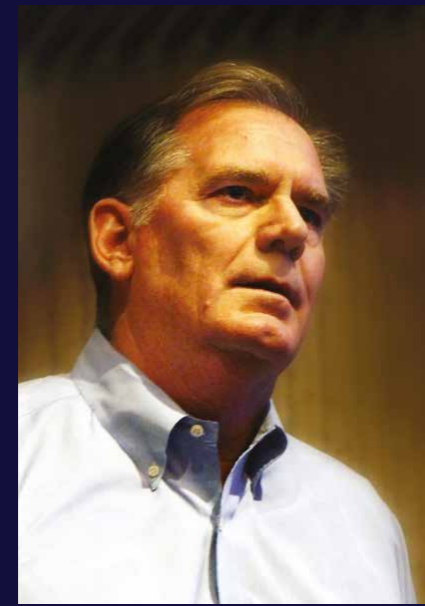

安德鲁·维尔德教授是美国斯坦福大学人文与科学学院Denise O'Leary and Kent Thiry社会学讲座教授、Freeman Spogli国际问题研究院高级研究员、美国文理学院院士。作为一名政治社会学家，他对当代中国社会及政治经济有着深入的研究。在1987年加入哈佛大学前，他在哥伦比亚大学任教。1995年至1998年间，他就职于香港科技大学任社会科学系主任。在斯坦福大学任教期间，他曾担任社会学系主任，亚太研究中心主任，国际、比较及区域研究系主任。著有 *Fractured Rebellion: The Beijing Red Guard Movement* (2009) 和 *China Under Mao: A Revolution Derailed* (2015)。

Andrew G. Walder is the Denise O'Leary and Kent Thiry Professor (Sociology) in the School of Humanities and Sciences, and Senior Fellow in the Freeman Spogli Institute for International Studies. A political sociologist, Walder has long specialized on the study of contemporary Chinese society and political economy. He taught at Columbia University before moving to Harvard in 1987. From 1995 to 1998, he headed the Division of Social Sciences at the Hong Kong University of Science and Technology. At Stanford, he has served as Chair of the Department of Sociology, Director of the Asia-Pacific Research Center, and Director of the Division of International, Comparative, and Area Studies in the School of Humanities and Sciences. His most recent books are *Fractured Rebellion: The Beijing Red Guard Movement* (2009) and *China Under Mao: A Revolution Derailed* (2015). He is an elected member of the American Academy of Arts and Sciences.

He holds honorary positions at Jilin University, East China Normal University, and Zhongshan (Sun Yat-Sen) University. He completed a Visiting Research Professorship at the East Asia Institute of National University of Singapore and was Visiting Researcher at China Foreign Affairs University in Beijing and at East China Normal University in Shanghai.

Brantly Womack is Professor of Foreign Affairs and holds the Miller Center's C K Yen Chair at the University of Virginia. He received his BA in politics and philosophy from the University of Dallas, studied philosophy at the University of Munich, and received his MA and PhD in political science from University of Chicago. After post-doctoral research at the University of California, Berkeley, he taught at Northern Illinois University and at the School of Oriental and African Studies (SOAS) before coming to University of Virginia.

Womack is the author of a number of books including *Asymmetry and International Relationships* (Cambridge University Press, 2016), *China Among Unequals: Asymmetric International Relationships in Asia* (World Scientific Press 2010), and of *China and Vietnam: The Politics of Asymmetry* (Cambridge University Press 2006), *Politics in China* (Little Brown, 1986), and *Foundations of Mao Zedong's Political Thought, 1917-1935* (Hawaii, 1982). Chinese translations of his books include *中国与越南：政治的非对称性* (2010), *中国政治* (1994, 2003), and *毛泽东政治思想的基础，1917-1935* (2006). He edited or co-edited *Borderlands in East and Southeast Asia: Emergent Conditions, Relations and Prototypes* (Routledge 2017), *Rethinking the Triangle: Washington-Beijing-Taipei* (World Scientific, 2016), *China's Rise in Historical Perspective* (Rowman and Littlefield 2010) and *Contemporary Chinese Politics in Historical Perspective* (Cambridge University Press 1991). He has authored more than a hundred articles and book chapters, primarily on Asian politics.

Womack has visited all of China's provinces and most of the countries of East and Southeast Asia. His research interests include

the long-term development of a multinodal global economy and the evolving situation of asymmetric parity between China and the United States. He is also interested in political reform in China and in relations between China and Southeast Asia. Recent publications on these themes have appeared in *International Affairs*, *Chinese Journal of International Politics*, *China: An International Journal*, *世界经济与政治*, and *Pacific Affairs*. In more theoretical areas, he is researching a general theory of democracy as well as the methodological foundations of the social sciences.

In 2011 Womack received the China Friendship Award for his work with Chinese universities. He holds honorary positions at Jilin University, East China Normal University, and Zhongshan (Sun Yat-Sen) University. He completed a Visiting Research Professorship at the East Asia Institute of National University of Singapore and was Visiting Researcher at China Foreign Affairs University in Beijing and at East China Normal University in Shanghai.

She has formed an applicable CGE model, named DRC-CGE model of China and has also trained a team of scholars working on this field. This model has been applied in many research projects both domestically and abroad. She won Fudan Management Excellence Award in 2014.

黄朗辉，中国知名的统计专家，1982年1月毕业于武汉科技大学机械工程专业，获工学学士学位。同年2月到国家统计局工业交通统计司工作。1986年，作为国家选派的访问学者赴加拿大国家统计局工作和研究一年多。1992年2月获得高级统计师职称。曾先后担任国家统计局企业调查总队总队长、城市调查总队总队长、国际统计信息中心主任。由于在全国统计调查和经济分析领域做出的突出贡献，于2017年初经国务院批准，荣获享受政府特殊津贴杰出专家称号。

黄朗辉在国家统计局先后负责全国价格统计、城市住户调查、企业改革调查和国际比较项目的理论研究、调查方案设计、调查组织实施、数据处理和相关经济研究工作。负责组织开展的全国性大型调查主要有：居民消费价格、工业生产者价格、企业原材料和燃料购进价格、投资价格、商品房价格等，并编制相应的价格指数；城镇居民收入和支出调查；企业改革进展，大型企业集团基本情况，建立现代企业制度进展情况调查；由联合国统计委员会主导的《国际比较项目》价格调查。他的研究成果和实践奠定了我国价格统计体系的理论框架，并不断改革完善，逐步投入实施，填补了中国价格统计领域里多项空白项目，提高了我国价格统计工作质量和国际化水平，为建立和完善我国价格统计体系、住户调查体系和国际比较工作体系，作出了突出贡献，也得到国际专家的高度评价。

黄朗辉教授主持的统计研究和经济分析的多篇课题成果在全国统计科研成果评比中获奖。主要有：

《建立和完善我国价格统计指标体系》、《城市高收入群体分析》、《首次全国城市居民家庭财产调查报告》、《中国通货膨胀趋势研究》，先后获得全国统计科研成果二等奖；《近期国际市场石油价格状况不容乐观》、《我国经济社会发展的国际地位比较》先后获得全国统计科研成果三等奖。有些经济分析报告曾作为中央、国务院进行决策的参考资料。

黄朗辉教授曾应邀担任政府机关、研究部门、大学等单位的专家和兼职教授，如国家发展改革委《政府价格工作专家组》成员，中国社会科学院城市发展与环境研究所专家组成员，武汉科技大学兼职教授，浙江大学经济系兼职教授，中国统计学会常务理事。现在担任中国老教授协会国杰研究院智库专家、中国小康建设智库专家，中国梦智库专家，21世纪经济报研究院专家组组长。他积极参与国际统计活动规则的研究和决策，曾担任国际调查统计学家学会执行委员会委员，国际官方统计学会区域与城市统计委员会执行委员会委员。在联合国统计委员会主导、世界银行和国际货币基金组织等国际机构实施的全球国际比较项目工作中，担任全球国际比较项目执行委员会中方代表，全球国际比较项目亚太地区咨询委员会委员。曾应邀作为高级访问研究员到新加坡国立大学东亚研究所进行学术交流。

Professor HUANG Langhui is a famous statistician in People's Republic of China. He obtained his Bachelor of Machine Engineering from the Wuhan University of Science and Technology, and began his statistical career at The National Bureau of Statistics of P.R. China at February 1982. From 1986 to 1987, he worked and carried out extensive research at the Statistics Canada on international statistics, as a visiting scholar. He had also a title as Senior Statistician in 1992. From 1988, he held respectively the position of the Director-General of the Department of Enterprises Survey, the Director-General of the Department of Urban Survey (in charge of price statistics, urban households income and expenditure, urban Basic statistics) and the Director-General of the Department of International Statistics Information. By virtue of his outstanding achievements on the nation-wide survey and economic analysis, he was conferred the title "Prominent Expert on Social Science" by the State Council of the P.R. China.

His work and research interests include price indexes, urban households' income and expenditure, enterprises performance and international comparison. The main work and research experiences have been on statistical survey design, economic analysis, including both theoretical and empirical studies. Main responsibility includes the leadership on the design and implementation of numerous nation-wide surveys, such as: Survey on consumer prices, industrial products prices and investments prices; Survey on income and expenditure of urban households; Survey on enterprise reform performance, enterprise corporations, how enterprises establish modern management system; Survey on the International Comparison Programme (ICP) sponsored by the UN Statistical Commission etc..

Numerous articles and technical reports under the direction of Professor Huang are written based on the survey and research. "The establishment and perfection on the system of price statistics indicators in China", "The first survey and research on the urban

households properties" and "The research on inflation trend in China" won respectively the second prize at the national statistical research competition. The State Council and other relevant government departments adopt many reports and papers for decision-making and policy design.

In addition, he participates in academic activities both at home and abroad actively, and has a wide range of influence.

He used to be invited to serve as an expert and a part-time professor in government agencies, research departments, and universities, such as the member of Expert Group on Government Price Issue from the National Development and Reform Commission, the member of the institute of urban development and environment, China Academy of Social Science, part-time professor from Wuhan University of Science and Technology, visiting professor of College of Economic Management, Zhejiang University, and the executive director of the national statistical society of China. Now he is working in the Xiaokang Construction Think Tank and China Dream Think Tank as an expert and working as the team leader of the expert group in Research Institute of 21st century Business Herald.

Professor HUANG Langhui also actively participates in statistic activities in the international. He used to be the member of Council of International Association of Survey Statisticians, and the member of Standing Committee on Regional and Urban Statistics under The International Association of Official Statistics (SCORUS), the representative of China in the International Comparison Programme which was directed by UN Statistical Commission and implemented by International Monetary Fund (IMF) and World Bank, and the member of ICP Asia-Pacific Advisory Committee. He also was invited as the senior visiting researcher to East Asian Institute of NUS for academic exchange with lecture topic "30 years statistical reform in China".

Dr. Cappelletti is scientific coordinator of a research project on the Belt and Road Initiative and Central Asia for Turin Polytechnic. Member of the Board of Directors of the Italian Research Institute on Contemporary China and former President of the cultural association Cinaforum, from 2016 to 2017 Dr. Cappelletti was responsible for a special project on Chinese economy and China-Italy economic relations for the Italian Ministry of Economic Development. In 2011 and 2012 she worked as consultant for the German bank KfW Bankegruppe for sociological and legal issues for the Land allocation monitoring mission of the Sino-German Xinjiang Poverty Alleviation Program in Kashgar, XUAR.
