Class Planning and Technology-Enhanced Learning

PARTICIPANTS

Anyone with a B2 level in Spanish or above, with little or no experience teaching Spanish as a Foreign Language.

COURSE DESCRIPTION

This course aims to provide a theoretical and practical framework for lesson planning in teaching Spanish as a Foreign Language, focusing on the implementation of Information and Communication Technology (ICT) in the classroom.

In this course, students will examine and reflect on learning activities' selection, lesson sequencing, time management, and general decision-making to achieve specific educational goals. Moreover, students will identify, adapt, and incorporate different ICTs into their lesson planning to create a technology-enhanced learning environment that fosters student engagement.

LANGUAGE

The course will be conducted in Spanish.

30 hours (synchronous sessions)
July 4-15, 2022
Monday to Friday, from 10:30 to 12:00 and 13:00 to 14:30.

STUDENT LEARNING OUTCOMES

At the end of this course, students will:

- **a.** Recognize the importance of lesson planning when designing classes.
- **b.** Identify and analyze the different stages of lesson planning and their specific goals.
- **c.** Select and sequence activities coherently to reach a particular learning objective or student learning outcome.
- **d.** Select, adapt, and use ICTs to design learning activities, practice content, give feedback, or engage students as an alternative to the regular manual used in class.
- e. Design a lesson plan and analyze other classmates' lesson plans.

METHODOLOGY

This course combines theoretical and practical reflection on learning processes and strategies related to course planning and the integration of ICTs into the classroom.

In the sessions and workshops, participants will reflect on the main elements to consider when planning a class, such as analyzing, adapting, and sequencing activities appropriately to achieve specific learning objectives taking into account different students' needs and interests. Different types of activities will be proposed to combine ICT with textbooks.

Classroom activities and tasks will be done cooperatively, promoting group dynamics and peer feedback, which will require the active and creative engagement of the participants.

ACADEMIC PROGRAM

This course will cover the following:

- Importance and stages of lesson planning.
- Activity sequencing.
- Essential elements of planning such as presentation and practice of vocabulary and grammar, time management, and skills.
- Use of ITCs to create and adapt teaching materials.
- Reflection on the learning process.

CERTIFICATE

Students will receive a certificate of achievement if they complete a portfolio (minimum 80% of the tasks done in class) and attend 80% of the scheduled sessions.

Ms. Edith Aurrecoechea has extensive experience teaching Spanish as a Foreign Language and has been a teacher trainer since 2001. She has combined both practices in different institutions in Spain, Singapore, India, and China.
