Requirements:

The candidate should have a first class or upper second class honours degree, or a master's degree (or equivalent qualification), in **Biological Sciences**, **Bioinformatics**, **Microbiology**, **Molecular Biology**, **Environmental Sciences**, or **Biostatistics**. Evidence of good spoken and written English is essential. The candidate should have an IELTS score of 6.5 or above, if the first language is not English. This position is open to all qualified candidates irrespective of nationality.

Degree:

The student will be awarded a PhD degree from the University of Liverpool (UK) upon successful completion of the program.

Funding:

The PhD studentship is available for three years subject to satisfactory progress by the student. The award covers tuition fees for three years (currently equivalent to RMB 99,000 per annum) and provides a monthly stipend of 5,000 RMB as a contribution to living expenses. It also provides up to RMB 16,500 to allow participation at international conferences during the period of the award. It is a condition of the award that holders of XJTLU PhD scholarships carry out 300-500 hours of teaching assistance work per year. The scholarship holder is expected to carry out the major part of his or her research at XJTLU in Suzhou, China. However, he or she is eligible for a research



study visit to the University of Liverpool of up to six months, if this is required by the project.

Project Description:

Pathogens in clinical environments can lead to hospital-acquired infections (HAIs). This is particularly concerning in intensive care units (ICUs), where critically ill patients are particularly vulnerable to pathogens. The dissemination of antimicrobial resistance can exacerbate the threat of pathogens to human health. Although disinfection is essential for pathogen control, its residuals may contribute to developing and spreading antimicrobial resistance due to the reinforced disinfection during and after Covid-19. However, the prevalence of hospital pathogens and their antimicrobial resistance in the post-Covid-19 era remains largely unknown. In this study, we aim to investigate the airborne and surface microbiomes and resistomes in an ICU using shotgun metagenomic sequencing. Our findings will elucidate the mechanisms underlying the formation and dynamics of the hospital pathogens, which may contribute to reducing HAIs and safeguarding the health of patients and medical staff.
