

## Policy Recommendations for Gusu District Fully Participating in the China-Singapore Cooperation

### Abstract

The Suzhou Industrial Park (SIP) was officially launched as the first intergovernmental collaboration project between China and Singapore in 1994. Over the last 29 years, the China-Singapore cooperation has been extended to the entire Suzhou city in all fields and in all directions. As the political, educational, cultural and tourism centre of Suzhou, Gusu District's active participation in the China-Singapore cooperation conforms to the long-term development strategy of Suzhou. Based on the analysis of the characteristics of Singapore's urban construction, industrial structure, and investment in China, this report proposes policy recommendations for Gusu District fully participating in the China-Singapore Cooperation in terms of integrated development of culture, business and tourism, exchange in medical and wellness industry, construction of intelligent transportation, renewal of commercial complex, and development of industrial land.
