



ACADEMIC BOARD

Terms of Reference

1. The Academic Board has oversight of all academic affairs of the University, and consequently is responsible ensuring the quality and standards of the University's academic provision.
2. The Academic Board is responsible, through the Executive President, to the Board of Directors.
3. The Academic Board shall discharge its responsibilities, without prejudice, to those executive powers that are vested in the President, the Executive President and other senior officers of the University.
4. Subject to the overall responsibility of the Board of Directors and to the provision contained in the 'Principles and Regulations' of XJTLU, and to the requirements of other validating and accrediting institutions, Academic Board shall have the following powers and duties which include but not restricted to
 - a. To act as the senior deliberative and consultative academic committee of the University on matters of academic strategy and policy, advising the Board of Directors and the University's Senior Management Team on such matters as required;
 - b. To make recommendations for approval by the Board of Directors, of any amendments to the 'Principles and Regulations' of the University;
 - c. To consider matters relating to the development of academic activities of the University and the resources needed to support them;
 - d. To oversee the development of curricula, including receipt of information on curricula, and review of new academic programmes that have already been approved by the University Learning and Teaching Committee; to revoke approvals made by the University Learning and Teaching Committee in exceptional circumstances, and to make recommendations to accrediting institutions to establish new degrees or other academic awards, where relevant;
 - e. To make regulations governing programmes of study, including the criteria for the admission and progression of students;
 - f. To oversee the award of degrees, diplomas and certificates of the University and any other institution under an accreditation agreement, and, where necessary, to revoke such degrees, diplomas and certificates;
 - g. To approve appointments of honorary and visiting posts;

- h. To recommend to the University's Senior Management Team candidates for the award of University Honorary Degrees;
 - i. To promote research and knowledge exchange within the University and to oversee the governance of research at the University;
 - j. To promote the maintenance and enhancement of appropriate quality and standards in the University's academic provision, including provision offered in collaboration with other institutions and organisations;
 - k. To regulate and superintend the discipline of students of the University, taking oversight of the Student Disciplinary Procedures and the operation of the Student Board of Discipline and Board of Appeal;
 - l. To advise on such other matters as the Board of Directors or the Executive President may, from time to time, refer to the Academic Board.
5. Subject to the 'Principles and Regulations', the Academic Board may establish such subordinate committees as it considers necessary for the purposes of enabling it to carry out its powers and responsibilities. The Academic Board may delegate any power and any duty to any subordinate committee, in order that the power and duty, whilst the delegation remains in force, shall be exercisable wholly or in part by the subordinate committee. Such delegated powers will be set out in the 'Scheme of Delegation'.

Membership

6. The following shall be members of the Academic Board:
- i. The Executive President (Chair), ex-officio
 - ii. The Vice-Presidents, ex-officio
 - iii. The Chief Officer of Ecology, ex-officio
 - iv. The Chief Officer of Education, ex-officio
 - v. The Director of Centre for Academic Affairs, ex-officio
 - vi. Associate Vice President-Education
 - vii. Associate Vice President- Research&Impact
 - viii. Deans of Schools/Academies, ex officio
 - ix. Heads of Departments, ex- officio
 - x. Director of XJTLU Graduate School, ex-officio
 - xi. Year 1 Director, ex-officio
 - xii. One to two full-time academic staff elected from each School/Academy

depending on the relative size of the School/Academy normally for a two-year term. Under normal circumstances, where the staffing size of a School/Academy constitutes 10% or greater of the overall academic staff in Academic Affairs, the elected representatives would be two.

- xiii. One member of teaching staff elected from the Chinese Cultural Teaching Centre, normally for a two-year term.
 - xiv. One member of teaching staff elected from the Physical Education Centre, normally for a two-year term.
 - xv. One undergraduate student, one master's student and one doctoral student, normally for a one-year term.
7. Nomination and election process of members described in item 6 will be announced annually.
8. The Executive President may nominate a Deputy Chair from among the members of the Academic Board to take the Chair in his/her place.
9. The following functional unit leaders will attend by invitation but not have voting powers:
- i. Registry
 - ii. Research Management Office
 - iii. Research Engagement and Innovation Office
 - iv. Campus Management Office
 - v. Human Resources Office
 - vi. Student Affairs Office
 - vii. Management Information and Technology and System Office
 - viii. Library
 - ix. University Marketing and Communications
 - x. X-Global
 - xi. Education and Quality Assurance Office
 - xii. XJTLU Graduate School
10. The Secretary to the Academic Board will be a member of Professional Services staff from the Centre for Academic Affairs.

Frequency of meetings and quorum

11. The Academic Board shall meet on at least three occasions in each academic year.
12. The quorum shall be at least one half of the Board's membership and at least one Vice-

President.
