Requirements:

A Master's degree with Merit and a Bachelor's degree with first-class or upper secondclass honors are required for PhD admissions. Exceptional candidates holding only a Bachelor's degree may be considered on an individual basis in certain disciplines. The candidate should major in computer science, computer engineering, automotive engineering, electrical engineering, or a closely related field. The preference will be given to applicants with the expertise in cybersecurity and machine learning.

Evidence of good spoken and written English is essential. The candidate should have an IELTS (or equivalent) score of 6.5 or above, if the first language is not English. This position is open to all qualified candidates irrespective of nationality.

Please note that the joint PhD project is industry-based and the candidate is expected to undertake part of the research at the partner organization in China.

Degree:

The student will be awarded a PhD degree from the University of Liverpool (UK) upon successful completion of the program.
