

MESSAGES FROM PRESIDENTS

Dear Students,

Welcome to Xi'an Jiaotong-Liverpool University (XJTLU)!

We hope that the summer sun not only marks the end of your high school journey but also energizes you for the upcoming university life.

At XJTLU, we regard students as young adults. You must bravely step out of your parents' protection, actively face various challenges such as developing proactive learning skills, balancing academics and extracurricular activities, getting along with roommates and classmates, and resisting the temptation of excessive online gaming, among others. You should learn to take responsibility for yourself, your family, and society. Transitioning from a child to an adult is challenging and sometimes painful, but it is precisely the fertile ground for growth.

XJTLU's core philosophy is "happy life and successful career," aiming to nurture students into global citizens with international perspectives and competitiveness. However, the realization of this philosophy and goal relies on your comprehensive development, various skills training, and personal growth during your time here. The university has established a "Five-Star" education model that adapts to global development trends and needs, integrating Eastern and Western wisdom, culture, and educational essence. We continuously strengthen our education philosophy focused on students' healthy growth, interest-driven and learning-centered approach, advocating for research-led learning. Obtaining dual degrees is merely a by-product of your studies; the lifelong benefits include your healthy development and the ability to utilize XJTLU's international learning environment and global educational resources to

enhance your lifelong learning capabilities, integrate and apply knowledge to solve problems, and improve your abilities in innovation, collaboration, and execution, especially your leadership in navigating the complex and ever-changing future world.

Under the influence of long-term exam-oriented education, parental protection, and "spoon-fed" teaching methods, you may be accustomed to passive learning: listening to teachers, memorizing knowledge points, and excelling in exams. This learning habit is not conducive to training the skills needed for the future. In order to address increasingly complex and pressing global challenges—especially the reshaping of human life and society by AI—you must strive to shift from passive learning to active learning, learn in collaboration with AI, and gradually transition toward research-oriented learning, "challenging" teachers and existing knowledge, enhancing classroom interaction and teamwork, actively participating in various innovations and practices, adapting to diverse teaching methods, and proactively using the "four-in-one" mentor system of Academic Advisors, Development Advisors, External Mentors, and Buddies, as well as various opportunities, resources, and the One-stop Student Service Centre for support.

To cultivate elite talents with curiosity, critical thinking, creative behavior, complex minds, lifelong learning, and cross-cultural leadership skills, XJTLU has developed and innovated its unique educational system by integrating the flexibility of American education, the quality control system of British education, and the foundational emphasis of Chinese education.

The XJTLU 1.0 model has upgraded the globally popular programme-based education system, initially forming an innovative "International Professional

Elite" training model. The sixteen cohorts of graduates to date have delivered outstanding performances, proving the feasibility and high quality of this educational model.

Facing the challenges of the era of digitalisation and AI, XJTLU remains true to its original aspirations and focuses on the future. Continuing to deepen and perfect the 1.0 model, XJTLU has pioneered the new "Syntegrative Education (SE)" or XJTLU 2.0 model. This model aims to train "International Industry Elites" who can stand on the shoulders of AI and robotics to lead new industries, and it explores new concepts for future universities and campus forms. SE integrates general education, programme-based education, industry education, management, and entrepreneurship education, merging campus learning, corporate practice, industry leadership, and social development to cultivate international industry elites with solid professional foundations, deep industry expertise, strong cross-cultural leadership, and entrepreneurial spirit, skilled in imagination and integrative innovation, thereby helping students to pioneer new industries and grow into talents capable of quickly integrating into society and taking the lead in their fields. In 2022, a brand-new international campus supporting symbiosis, syntegration, innovation, and entrepreneurship was established in Taicang, Suzhou. Seven industry-themed schools were created, and to date, three cohorts of graduates have confidently stepped into society, demonstrating through their outstanding performance the value of the SE model, and significantly expanding the scope of XJTLU's educational exploration.

On the 15th anniversary of its establishment, XJTLU has fully launched its 3.0 model, deeply exploring how universities can integrate into society, leverage various resources, and create an industrial innovation

ecosystem linked by education. The flagship projects of the established XJTLU 3.0 model include: XJTLU Wisdom Lake Academy of Pharmacy, Academy of Future Education, Academy of Film and Creative Technology, XJTLU - JITRI Academy of Industrial Technology, and its innovation platforms: XJTLU AI Innovation Alliance, College of Industry-Entrepreneurs, X-Eco Mall and the XJTLU Advanced Materials Research Center, the Post-Quantum Migration Interdisciplinary Lab, and the Institute for Low Altitude Innovation along with a series of other newly launched interdisciplinary innovation centres, aiming to play the role of a “catalyst” and “adhesive” in cooperation with governments, international industries, financial alliances, and social resources to provide you with a richer and more outstanding immersive learning, research, and practical environment.

To support your learning experience and the effective implementation of the three different educational models, XJTLU established the Learning Mall in 2020. This initiative leverages XJTLU’s world-class campus environment and advanced technology to integrate excellent global online educational resources and providers, achieving a deep integration of on-campus and off-campus, online and offline resources to support interest-driven and personalized lifelong learning for students and society at large.

To ensure the continuous upgrade of XJTLU’s education, promote personalized learning and teaching innovation, and implement more flexible credit education, XJTLU launched the Extended Study Scheme (ESS) in 2022, allowing you to choose programmes according to your life plans and design your learning journey based on personal interests, further unlocking your potential and embarking on a more spectacular life.

Facing the era of artificial intelligence and robotics, XJTLU has, based on many years of “digitalization” exploration, comprehensively reviewed, innovated, and upgraded existing teaching and support systems through the “Education+AI” project initiated in 2024, and integrated into society to carry out “+AI” cross-industry projects, aiming to lead educational innovation and industrial transformation from dimensions of educational systems, organizational management, and cooperation among industry, academia, government, and society.


Dear Students,






PRESIDENT XI SAYS XJTLU HELPS STUDENTS ACHIEVE THREE TRANSFORMATIONS!



XJTLU FIVE-STAR EDUCATION MODEL

For Xi'an Jiaotong-Liverpool University students, the transformation to 'young adults' is just the first step. The mission of XJTLU is to cultivate students to be 'global citizens'. One of the core parts of becoming global citizens is to equip themselves with international competitiveness. After constant explorations, XJTLU has put forward three systems, namely the Philosophy & Value System, the Capability System, and the Knowledge System, which represent students' development and growth in three dimensions. To achieve this goal, we combine the best of eastern and western education models, resulting in a Comprehensive Education Strategy and Support System of Implementation. The XJTLU External Mentor Project is a vital pillar of Xi’an Jiaotong-Liverpool University’s unique educational system. Its original purpose is to assist students during the critical transition from campus to society. By bridging gaps in real-world experience, it provides students with practical wisdom and guidance from industry professionals.

Mentors, with their rich career insights and life experiences, empower students with clarity and motivation, fostering continuous growth in competencies, knowledge, skills, and judgment. This prepares them to seamlessly integrate into society and extend their development to broader life and career stages.

Initiated in 2009, the XJTLU External Mentor Project, underpinned by the ethos of ‘Light and Wings’, operates under the guiding principle of ‘Walk with the outstanding person, be outstanding’. Its mission is to establish meaningful connections between students and distinguished professionals from a wide array of societal sectors. Presently, the project encompasses over 1,500 elite mentors from diverse professional backgrounds.

The project facilitates personalised support, shares valuable industry resources, fosters university-corporate collaborations, enhances the integration of industry with education, and offers access to both research and practical projects, among extensive other practical activities.

Through these comprehensive strategies, it aims to impart practical experience and industry insights, providing students with varied mentorship and extensive growth opportunities. Their guidance helps students gain early exposure to industry trends, accumulate hands-on experience, and build essential resources and capabilities, laying a solid foundation for future career success.

BUDDY PROGRAMME

The Buddy Programme at XJTLU assists new students in adapting to university life through peer mentoring while building a platform for cross-cultural engagement.

Chen Weiye, a first-year student majoring in Applied Mathematics, initially found calculus and linear algebra challenging. “At the beginning, I couldn’t understand much in class. So I kept ‘bothering’ my big buddy - often sending her questions on WeChat even when she was relaxing - but she always responded patiently.”

ACADEMIC ADVISOR

All academic staff act as Academic Advisors to a certain group of designated students in their schools. Your Academic Advisor is expected to be available for at least one hour per week to answer your queries as responsibilities advisees. Their roles are mainly:

- to advocate for you if you are in serious personal or academic difficulty
- to provide references for you as appropriate
- to support you in fulfilling the requirements of work placements and sign off of these placements
- to answer questions and give advice to their advisees about their academic and career development, such as selections on optional modules, Extended Study Scheme (ESS) modules and the undergraduate programme of study
- to discuss any prolonged or recurrent absences or lack of engagement

During Stage 1, your Academic Advisor will be a Stage 1 language or mathematics teacher. After the Programme Choice event in Semester 2, when you are admitted into a programme of your choice, your Academic Advisor will be an academic staff member from the School that your programme of study belongs to.

You can check your Academic Advisor's information on the programme and module page of e-Bridge. Communications between you and your Academic Advisor are, in the first instance, confidential. Where there is any concern about the health or safety of the student or of other members of the university community, the Academic Advisor may share the information with the relevant office on campus for follow-up.

At XJTLU, every student will have a dedicated Development Advisor. Development Advisors (DAs) are mentors, friends, and a reliable support system. Like a trusted 'old friend', your DA will accompany you through every stage of university, sharing experiences, helping you overcome difficulties, and offering guidance. We will pay attention to your overall performance, fully understand your learning and living situations, guided by XJTLU's 'Three Transformations', support your personal development, and provide timely feedback.

THE 'THREE TRANSFORMATIONS': LIGHTING THE WAY ON YOUR UNIVERSITY JOURNEY

University life marks the critical stage for achieving the 'Three Transformations.' As one of the four key roles in XJTLU's holistic advising system, Development Advisors aim to guide students through this transformative process by acting as:

- Advisors who help you navigate your growth journey
- Coordinators who connect you with various university resources, and
- Experts who provide professional, student-centred support.

To help you achieve these 'Three Transformations', we offer the following support:

INDIVIDUAL SUPPORT

Focusing on the overall performance of individual students at XJTLU, we have a comprehensive understanding of students' life and learning during your school years, and support students and give you feedback to help you grow with the guiding principle of 'Three Transformations' of XJTLU. We provide a variety of opportunities for outstanding students to expand their abilities and motivate them to develop. We provide specialised support for students facing challenges, including academic risks (missing exams, failing classes, repeating modules), school integration, interpersonal interactions, etc., and work together with the faculty to support students' growth and development in both life and academics.



COMMUNITY CONSTRUCTION	We help students build their communities through the schools and classes. Through various support programmes, themed class meetings, class activities, and workshops in their schools, we enrich the students' experience at school, take the lead in new student orientation and graduation education, and form an integrated support system.
RESOURCE INTEGRATION	Integrate various student service and support resources at the school and university levels, and establish a collaborative system with Academic Advisors, External Mentors, and peer mentors (first-year students) to jointly provide support for student growth.
CAREER SUPPORT	According to the features of students in different schools, majors and stages, we recommend a variety of career development services and resources for students, as well as coordinate workshops on further education and employment, and provide one-on-one evaluation, interview and resource recommendation services for students in their last year and alumni within 6 months of graduation.
EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT	Student Development Advisors respond to emergency cases according to the emergency procedures of the university.

The project adheres to the philosophy of 'Walk with the outstanding person, be outstanding', to enhance students' comprehensive growth.



XJTLU EXTERNAL MENTOR-STUDENT ONLINE MUTUAL-SELECTION

The XJTLU External Mentor-Student Online Mutual-Selection is conducted at the beginning of each semester, open to students from the first year to the postgraduate level. Through this mutual selection process, exclusive mentoring relationships are established, creating diversified and personalised guidance opportunities.



THE NAVIGATION SERIES: ON-CAMPUS LECTURES

The Navigation Series activities, themed 'Piloting Your Career Path, Charting Your Future', invite External Mentors to campus for industry sharing sessions and face-to-face discussions. These events facilitate in-depth conversations about the past, present and future of various industries whilst exploring endless practical and entrepreneurial opportunities together.



XJTLU EXTERNAL MENTOR RESEARCH OR PRACTICAL PROJECT

The XJTLU External Mentor Research or Practical Project provides students with research or practical opportunities based on mentors' professional expertise and work experience. These projects immerse students in the latest industry trends and research developments whilst helping them accumulate career-critical skills. By integrating academic knowledge with practical work requirements, mentors guide students to participate in real work scenarios for experiential learning and growth.



ABOVE CLOUD—EXTERNAL MENTOR ONLINE 1V1 CONSULTATION

Above Cloud is a one-on-one online career consultation activity launched by the XJTLU Career Centre. Each session invites several external mentors to open consultation slots in the mentor consultation section of the XJTLU Career Centre website. Students can access personalised online consultations to obtain cutting-edge industry information, graduation direction guidance, career interest development, and customised career planning advice.



MORNING STAR CAREER CONSULTATION MENTOR GROUP

The Morning Star Career Consultation Mentor Group invites external mentors to the XJTLU Career Centre, providing students with opportunities for face-to-face communication with elites from various fields. Catering to the diverse needs of students from different majors, weekly consultation themes are set and open to all students, offering professional, customised and in-person guidance.



BUDDY PROGRAMME

Since its establishment in 2009, the Buddy Programme has embodied a heartwarming tradition that transcends time through the playful terms 'Big Buddies' and 'Little Buddies' terms that symbolise the intergenerational bond of support. Operated by the Buddy Programme Executive Committee (BPEC), a student-led organisation, this peer initiative constructs a comprehensive growth network spanning academics, daily life, and culture through four support systems: local buddy, class buddy, overseas buddy and alumni buddy. Each academic year at the start of term, Big Buddies act as guides, accompanying Buddies through the 'three transformations'. Their support includes full-English course adaptation guides, Suzhou living handbooks, and cross-cultural exchange insights, all designed to facilitate this transitional journey. As President Youmin Xi noted, the 'Buddy Programme means walking alongside friends, fostering mutual aid for shared growth, and achieving common prosperity through symbiosis.'

This vision comes to life in countless moments: when international freshmen receive handwritten welcome cards at the airport, or when local students share Mid-Autumn traditions at cultural salons. More than a one-way assistance model, this reciprocal journey of growth bridges distances and cultures - Malaysian students bringing Jiangnan tea snacks back to their homeland, British exchange students greeting others with the Suzhou dialect '侬好' and countless Little Buddies eventually evolving into Big Buddies themselves. Together, they weave XJTLU's unique international humanistic bond, where every connection nurtures both individual growth and collective belonging.

LOCAL BUDDY

Before the first year students enroll, local buddy, as the local seniors, answer questions and overcome doubts for the freshmen in the official QQ group of the student hometown and help everyone understand the study and life of XJTLU in advance.



CLASS BUDDY

After the first year freshmen enrolment, the Class Buddies guide the freshmen to familiarise themselves with the campus, adapt to XJTLU, and answer various questions they have after entering XJTLU.

The Buddy Programme provides several big buddies for each administrative class to help freshmen adapt to university life smoothly. In order to make it easier for freshmen to participate in campus tours and other activities, we randomly assign a big buddy to each freshman. The freshmen will receive information such as the name and email address of the big buddy from the Buddy Programme Executive Committee (Buddy@xjtlu.edu.cn) before the start of semester. We strongly encourage all freshmen to take the initiative to send the first greeting email to their big buddy and open a new chapter exclusive to you!

TIPS FROM THE BUDDY PROGRAMME

Big buddies are a group of volunteers who are eager to help the younger students. They are not only the peer mentors of the freshmen, but also experienced seniors.

So how should a freshman start the first step of friendship with the big buddies?

- **Respect:** respect means acceptance and equality. Polite manner and appropriate content are the first steps in learning how to socialise with peers.
- **Sincerity:** sincerity is based on the concern and love for each other, and it is also based on the conditions of self-acceptance, self-confidence and humility. When we care about each other with sincerity, we will often reap corresponding care.
- **Empathy:** put yourself in the shoes of others to understand the mood and viewpoint of the person concerned. As a little buddy, we accept the care and love of the big buddy, but perhaps they also need the encouragement and understanding of the younger students. Caring is never one-sided, but a virtuous circle that goes both ways.

We hope that everyone can find a guide to accompany them in the atmosphere of universal love, and become a confident, diverse and free global citizen in the upcoming university life.

BUDDY DECOMPRESSION GROCERY STORE:

Whenever the end of term is approaching, the Buddy Programme will set up a buddy unzip grocery store around campus. Decompression dolls, free hugs, sending messages to each other are examples. They will relieve the pressure of students before the exams and help them free themselves from the exams.

APPENDIX: XJTLU STUDENT SUBSIDY PROGRAMME

XJTLU's subsidy system, combined with the university's unique characteristics, consists of national scholarships, subsidies and loans as well as university scholarships. Let's have a quick look at it now.

STUDENT LOANS	Locally Granted Student Loan. Students with financial difficulties can apply for a loan (RMB 20,000 per person per year) to pay for tuition fees and accommodation fees. Students can contact their local Subsidy Centre for detailed application procedures.
	Entry Scholarships The Entry Scholarship is set up to reward students with outstanding academic performance, critical thinking and interdisciplinary creative problem-solving skills, and international perspective and competitiveness. The scholarship is renewable subject to the fulfilment of the appropriate criteria, as set out in the Regulations for Entrance Scholarship for Local Undergraduate Students.
	Progression Scholarships Students can be granted RMB 5,000 or 10,000 when meeting the conditions of the progression scholarship.
SCHOLARSHIPS, SUBSIDIES AND HONORS	National Scholarships The national scholarship (RMB 10,000 per person per year) is granted to outstanding students in Y2 and above. The number of students who receive the scholarship is subject to the quota allocated by the Education Department of Jiangsu Province.
	National Encouragement Scholarships The scholarship (RMB 6,000 per person per year) is granted to outstanding Y2 and above students with financial difficulties. The number of students who receive the subsidy is subject to the quota allocated by the Education Department of Jiangsu Province.
	National Subsidies Students with financial difficulties could apply for the subsidy which is granted according to difficulty level with RMB 3700 per person per year on average. The subsidy object is affirmed by family economy situation which will be verified every academic year. Students need to apply on Jiangsu Student Subsidy Application System in Semester 1. Students who are retired soldiers will be granted the national subsidy of RMB 3700 yuan per person per year
SPECIAL-PURPOSE SUBSIDIES	Appraisal Outstanding students, student cadres and students with achievements in certain areas will be granted related honors, which include University-level and Province-level Outstanding Student and Excellent Student Cadre, etc.
	Military Service Education Subsidies Local students who are enrolled and enlist in the military will receive tuition fees reimbursements for enlistment or tuition fee remission for discharge from the military, with the funding amount not exceeding RMB 20,000 per person per year.
	Grass-Roots Employment Subsidies Undergraduates working in related grass-roots communities in northern Jiangsu areas will be granted no more than RMB 8,000 per person per year for a tuition fee waiver after serving in their jobs for 36 months.

LOCAL STUDENT ACCOMMODATION SUPPORT


Dear Students

The Dushu Lake Science & Education Innovation District has adopted a socialisation management model for student accommodation. The SDLSED (Suzhou Dushu Lake Science and Education Development Co., Ltd) builds and manages the student dormitories. The SDLSED employs property management companies to provide property services for students. Usually, four undergraduates share one dorm, which is equipped with a bathroom, furniture, air-conditioner, water heater, and other things. Room facilities may vary as different halls were built at different times. Local accommodation resources and services in this town are shared by both XJTLU students and students from other universities together.

The XJTLU Entrepreneur Apartment (Taicang) project is invested, constructed, and managed by the Taicang Culture and Education Investment Group Co., Ltd, adhering to a unified property management service model. It provides three room types: single, double, and quadruple occupancy, all equipped with furniture, lighting systems, air conditioning, private bathrooms, and balconies, complemented by shared communal spaces within the building. Although these two projects are administered by distinct management entities, both implement centralised management of student accommodation resources through socialized operational frameworks, ensuring efficient integration of housing services.

The Student Accommodation Support Team (SAST) provides accommodation application and counselling services to local students. The Student Accommodation Committee was established in 2009 as a student self-government organisation. For accommodation support, students can contact the Student Accommodation Support Team or the Student Accommodation Committee.

- The Student Accommodation Committee provides students with daily business support such as accommodation counselling, suggestion collection, accommodation culture creation, etc. Through a series of business support, the Student Accommodation Committee hopes to help students develop good living habits, create a healthy residence culture, and solve the difficulties encountered by students in their daily lives.
- As a bridge between student residents and dormitory owners, the Student Accommodation Committee actively communicates and coordinates with property managers through meetings, and tries its best to strive for optimal dormitory services for XJTLU students.
- The Student Accommodation Committee cooperates with the property management of the dormitory area to conduct regular dormitory safety visits to strengthen students' awareness of dormitory safety.
- The Student Accommodation Committee regularly participates in the night duty service of each dormitory area to provide students with convenient dormitory support.



Dormitory life is a unique chapter of university life. In this small world of dormitories, students from all over the country learn, live and grow together. In order to create a harmonious, healthy, happy, helpful dormitory community culture, and to help students better adapt to their university lives, the Student Accommodation Support Team (SAST) provides students with three aspects of warm tips on overall dormitory adjustment, dormitory public safety and dormitory community life.

WARM TIPS FOR OVERALL DORMITORY ADJUSTMENT

To protect students' rights and interests in accommodation, the overall adjustment of dormitories is an initiative to cope with the pressure on dormitory resources at this stage to create an orderly and harmonious living environment for students.

- To optimise the accommodation resources and to enhance your living experiences, it is expected that some student dormitories will be reorganised and adjusted according to the dormitory resources every year.
- The aim is to create a more harmonious and convenient living environment for students, and at the same time ensure the rational allocation and efficient use of dormitory resources.
- This will help students to better integrate and lay a good foundation for the accommodation arrangements in the new academic year.

TIPS FOR DORMITORY PUBLIC SAFETY

Dormitory safety is the primary defence of collective life. As a "small family" living together, students should always keep safety in mind:

- Prohibit smoking (including electronic cigarettes) in all areas of the dormitory.
- Don't use open flames, burn things, etc., and stay away from combustible materials.
- Unauthorized wiring and the use of prohibited electrical appliances are strictly forbidden.
- Don't put electric items such as sockets and chargers on the bed.
- Turn off the water and electricity, unplug the cords, and switch off the lights before leaving the room.
- Charging of all large-capacity power batteries and accumulators indoors is strictly forbidden. For electric two-wheelers, parking and charging must be conducted in accordance with the property management's stipulated requirements.
- Prohibit putting rubbish and sundries at the entrance of the dormitory, and ensure that the fire escape is clear.

TIPS FOR DORMITORY COMMUNITY LIFE

Dormitory life is the cradle of common growth in the university journey. During the days of living together, except for the 'dormitory agreement' signed by roommates, understanding and consideration are the basis of harmony:

- Respect for work and rest time. Uniformly agree on a shared schedule for lights out, sleeping / waking up to reduce noise and avoid disturbing your roommates.
- Maintain cleanliness. Take turns to clean the common areas, store your personal belongings neatly, and clean up rubbish in a timely manner to maintain the quality of life in the dormitory.
- Protect your roommate's privacy. Don't touch your roommate's belongings without permission, and ask for permission to borrow things. Use common space reasonably and avoid prolonged occupation.
- Reduce noise interference. Wear headphones when listening to music, watching videos or playing games, and avoid loud noises in the dormitory.
- Tolerance of differences. Respect different living habits and cultural backgrounds. Communicate frankly when encountering conflicts in the dormitory, think constructively, and negotiate to solve the problem, or ask teachers to help mediate if necessary.
- Help each other. Share small gifts and other small kindnesses to create a friendly and supportive atmosphere in the dormitory.

The Student Counselling Centre has assembled a high-quality team of professional counsellors to provide you with care, support, and educational guidance, ensuring your university journey is both fulfilling and well-supported every step of the way.

WHAT IS COUNSELLING?

Clients bring their problems to counselling and then, under the joint efforts of clients and counsellors, clients find the inner insight collaboratively with the counsellor. Further on, clients will develop further self-growth.

Counselling can be conducted not only by talking, but also by sand play or art therapy. During this process, relative to giving direct guidance, education or opinions, counsellors put more efforts on exploring clients' own power to improve their current distresses. In this way the counsellor can help clients develop the ability to deal with difficult situations after the end of counselling.

HOW TO MAKE AN APPOINTMENT FOR INDIVIDUAL COUNSELLING

You can personally schedule psychological counselling appointments directly through the SCC website. The website URL can be found in the QR code on the right.

WHAT ISSUES CAN I TAKE TO THE XJTLU STUDENT COUNSELLING CENTRE?

The scope of counselling includes academic stress, interpersonal problems, emotional confusion, family relationships, career planning and other issues, as well as counselling for depression, compulsion, anxiety, social phobia and other psychological disorders. It should be noted that the counselling for all kinds of psychological disorders can only have an effect and significance on the basis of medical diagnosis and stable medication.

OTHER SERVICES WE PROVIDE

ONLINE ADAPTATION SURVEY FOR FIRST-YEAR STUDENTS	In order to gain a better knowledge of the adaptability of new students, SCC will invite all first-year students to complete an online test, which will also remain confidential.
PSYCHOLOGY WORKSHOP	SCC will invite professional counsellors outside the university to hold psychology workshops on different topics, such as 'Mindfulness and Meditation,' 'Interpersonal Communication,' 'Manage your stress' and 'Emotion Lab,' for all students at XJTLU.
PSYCHOLOGICAL EDUCATION LECTURES	SCC also provides Psychological education lectures for XJTLU's students, covering multiple topics such as 'Interpersonal Relationships,' 'Depression,' and 'Psychological Adjustment for New Students.'
COUPLES COUNSELLING AND FAMILY COUNSELLING	SCC also provides couples counselling and family counselling services for students. For details, please contact the SCC to schedule an appointment. These services are primarily short-term, with each cycle consisting of 4-6 sessions, and require the participation of all relevant family members.
GROUP COUNSELLING	SCC also provides group counselling services for approximately 6-10 individuals who meet face-to-face with a trained group counsellor. Group counselling is commonly used for people with normal mental problems and it usually consists of 3-10 sessions of 1.5 hours each time.

THE FOLLOWING FOUR BUILDINGS ARE OF GREAT IMPORTANCE TO YOUR CAMPUS LIFE:

Foundation Building

The School of Languages is located in this building. You will take almost all the 1st year foundation courses here. In addition, many clubs' activities are held in the lobby of the ground floor.

Central Building

This is the administration building. Most functional departments are located here, such as the Library, Museum, Registry, X-Global, IT Service Centre, One-Stop Student Service Centre, Student Counselling Centre, Accommodation Service Centre, Student Club Service Centre, Careers Centre, Alumni Association, and more.

Public Building

This is the place where Student Development Advisors are located. If you have any confusion at the beginning of the semester, make an appointment and come to your Development Advisor's office for a consultation.

Gym

Here is the location of physical education classes, physical testing and sports fitness. In your spare time, you can come to the gym to exercise and relax.

The Sports Centre

The Sports Centre, an extension of the teaching area closely connected to the dormitory zone, is situated on a landscaped slope, harmonising with the architectural style of the teaching buildings. It meets students' daily exercise needs, featuring a three-story complex that includes a heated swimming pool and a smart fitness centre. The centre also houses multifunctional venues such as basketball courts, badminton courts, billiards rooms, table tennis halls, indoor golf facilities, squash courts, martial arts rooms, fencing rooms, and dance studios, along with a sports health monitoring system that provides customised training plans for students.

Innovation Factory

The Innovation Factory (IF) is built on a spirit of innovation, entrepreneurship and syntegrative education. It is linked to all the industrial schools at XEC campus and connects all the laboratory facilities with access to 60+ laboratories across the campus. IF as a springboard for innovators at XJTLU to try out ideas in the form of designs and turn them into products, processes or solutions.

Student Centre, Building J

The Student Centre is located in Building J which is an important venue for student club activities. Dear Students

XJTLU Registry welcomes you to your new start! Registry supports XJTLU's core activities of teaching and learning, manages student registration data, and provides a variety of academic registration-relevant services. Registry uses e-Bridge (<https://ebridge.xjtlu.edu.cn>), XJTLU's web-based student information system, to support academic registration and relevant core activities.

REGISTRATION

Annual registration is the process of confirming your academic and personal information at the beginning of each academic year. All students must finish online registration and financial registration on e-Bridge (<https://e-bridge.xjtlu.edu.cn>) before the start of each academic year. Please note the maximum registration period for undergraduate students is 8 years, which includes all periods of repeating levels of study, programme changes, or suspension of study.

MODULE, TIMETABLE AND ATTENDANCE

Please use the Timetable Plus platform to select optional modules during the designated time period, and you may check your module enrolment information on e-Bridge, including compulsory modules and optional modules. Your personal class timetable will be released on e-Bridge before the start of each semester. You will also be enrolled into your modules on XJTLU's virtual learning environment: the XJTLU Learning Mall Online. This online platform is designed to support and enhance learning and teaching activities. You can access the XJTLU Learning Mall Online in order to stay up-to-date with your modules, communicate with teachers, view important learning resources, and submit coursework assignments, and so on.

Additionally, please be aware that the university uses an Attendance Management System (AMS: <https://ams.xjtlu.edu.cn/>) to monitor student attendance, and you should study the Student Attendance Policy on the CAA@ E-BRIDGE-Document Zone of the Home Page of e-Bridge.

STUDENT RECORDS, TRANSCRIPTS AND OTHER CERTIFICATIONS

e-Bridge maintains your personal information and academic records during your time at XJTLU. You can access e-Bridge to check your module list, academic records, progression results, work placement records, and so on.

If you would like to request official transcripts and other certifications, please submit your request on the Academic Records page of e-Bridge. XJTLU has officially launched the electronic transcript and certification service. Once you submit the request successfully, the e-documents will be immediately delivered to your designated email address provided in the request form.

PROGRAMME CHOICE

Stage 1 new entry students admitted through Gaokao will need to make their programme choice in Semester 2 Stage 1. The selection of optional modules will affect your choice of programmes since some programmes have prerequisite requirements.

The Library at XJTLU Entrepreneur College (Taicang) opened in September 2022 with a total area of over 6,500 square metres and 400 seats. Both libraries provide varied functional areas for studying, discussion, computer labs and studio work. The design of XJTLU Library is rich in cultural and academic atmosphere.



ENGLISH LANGUAGE CENTRE

Dear Students

Welcome to XJTLU and the English Language Centre (ELC), part of the new Global Cultures and Languages Hub.

During your first two years at XJTLU, you will spend a lot of your time with lecturers from the Hub studying on our English for Academic Purposes (EAP) modules. We are dedicated to maximising your linguistic competence and academic potential through professional language training and continuous study support. The main purpose of studying with us is to learn, develop, and practice the English language and practical skills you will need to succeed in your academic disciplines, including independent learning and critical thinking. All these skills are a vital component of university study in an English language institution.

Your EAP journey will begin with the English Language Placement Test, which will take place online over the summer following your acceptance at XJTLU, but before you arrive on campus. We use an Online Placement Test to place you in an EAP module that is best suited to your needs. You will receive further instructions to your XJTLU email account on how to do this when you are accepted. Please ensure that you activate your XJTLU account, and then check your emails on a regular basis. Please pay attention to the information about the English Placement Test sent by EPT@xjtlu.edu.cn.

The EAP module you are placed in reflects the amount of time you will need in order to develop the necessary linguistic and practical skills for success at XJTLU. The Year 1 EAP modules have been designed to meet the specific needs of all English language levels. Therefore, it is vital that you complete the online placement test so that you are correctly placed onto the pathway most suited to your needs.

There are five main English for Academic Purposes pathways. All modules have the same learning outcomes, and also share assessments. The main difference between the modules is the number of hours per week of study:

FOUNDATION EAP	This is a 20-credit module aimed specifically at those with limited levels of English language proficiency. Students study for 16 hours per week. The main focus of the module is receptive skills (listening, reading), productive skills (speaking, writing) as well as additional language and academic skills.
PRE-INTERMEDIATE EAP	This is a 20-credit module aimed specifically at those with developing levels of English language proficiency. Students study for 12 hours per week. The main focus of the module is receptive skills (listening, reading), productive skills (speaking, writing) as well as additional language and academic skills.
INTERMEDIATE EAP	These are 20-credit modules aimed specifically at those with independent levels of English language proficiency. Students study for 10 hours per week. The main focus of the modules is receptive skills (listening, reading), productive skills (speaking, writing) as well as additional language and academic skills.
ADVANCED EAP	This is a 10-credit module aimed specifically at those with high levels of English language proficiency. Students study for 8 hours per week. The main focus of the module is receptive skills (listening, reading), productive skills (speaking, writing) as well as academic skills. Students on this module will be able to take additional Y1 Optional modules to further enhance their skillsets and develop their interests.
ADVANCED EAP (INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS)	These are two 5-credit modules (in S1 and S2) aimed specifically at international students with high levels of English language proficiency. Students study for 4 hours per week. The main focus of the modules is the use of research skills, presentations, and argumentation. Students on this module will be able to take additional Y1 Optional modules to further enhance their skillsets and develop their interests.

Upon the successful completion of your Year 1 EAP module, you will progress to Y2 of your degree programme. During this time, you will be supported by language teachers in the new Academic Literacies Centre. These staff members are there to provide language and academic support to help you pass your content and skills modules.

We wish you every success at XJTLU, and we are confident that you will find it an immensely rewarding experience.

PHYSICAL EDUCATION CENTRE

Dear Students

Welcome to Xi'an Jiaotong-Liverpool University! It's our great pleasure to greet you and welcome you to join our big family during this vibrant and hopeful season. As you embark on this new journey in your life, we hope that sports become a part of your daily life, accompanying you in your happy and healthy growth.

The Physical Education Centre, comprised of three teams, the PE Teaching Centre, Sports Centre (SIP) and Sports Centre (XEC), is devoted to helping students with their development for healthy bodies, good sportsmanship and sound personalities. The PE Teaching Centre is mainly responsible for the PE course teaching, sports team training and the organisation of the National Physical Fitness Test; the Sports Centre (SIP) and Sports Centre (XEC) take charge of the operation of the sports venues, sports clubs, and the support for sports events.

PE COURSE TEACHING

Acting upon the Five-Star Education Model and guided by the philosophy of Health First and Lifelong Sports, the PE Teaching Centre will help each student acquire at least one sport skill which is supposed to be developed into a lifelong habit. There are more than 20 different sport items open to all Y1 students each semester which vary from popular sports such as basketball, football, badminton, etc. to some minor sports such as golf, archery, fencing, frisbee, and so on. The choice of sport usually takes place during the first teaching week of each semester. The students can choose their one sport course on the online PE selection system based on their interest and by following the principle of 'first come, first served'.

SPORT EVENTS

The sport events are a vital part of the physical education in that they can not only test the student comprehensive physical fitness status, but also provide a good opportunity to enhance the communication among students, faculties and schools. Besides, the sport competitions can also help to develop students' tenacious characters and their strong will for excellence by creating learning opportunities for their leadership skills, teamwork spirit and problem-solving skills. Sport events of various levels have been created including intramurals such as the freshman competition series, School Cup, XJTLU Teacher-Student Badminton Competition, Track and field competition, and extramurals such as the XJTLU Cup International Sports League and School Teams Outside-school Competition, as well as some other municipal, provincial, national and international sport events.

STUDENT GROUPS OF SPORTS

The Physical Education Centre provides professional guidance and support services for 35 sports clubs and 10 sports teams. Sports clubs are more interest-driven, and devoted to the popular sports. With the principle of student autonomy, sport clubs, not only help students with the development of physical fitness but also with leadership skills and project management skills. Meanwhile, the sport teams focus more on competition and put stress on achievements, which require students to have a certain professional foundation.

PHYSICAL FITNESS TEST

In order to enhance students' overall health status and encourage them to develop a good habit for sport exercise, it's required by the Ministry of Education and the General Administration of Sport, that all the registered local undergraduates must undertake the National Physical Fitness Test each year during their university life. The test usually takes place between October and December during the first semester and the test items include eyesight, weight & height, vital capacity, standing long jump, sit and reach, pull-up (boys only), sit-up (girls only), a 50-metre run, 800-metre run (girls only), and 1000-metre run (boys only). The results of the physical fitness test will be included in the student personal files and only those who have achieved a passing grade or above in the physical fitness test are eligible for the relevant awards and commendations of the university.

SPORTS VENUES and FACILITIES

Both the SIP campus and the XEC campus of XJTLU are equipped with high-end sport venues and facilities, which are designed to meet the needs of staff and students in physical education, club activities, sport team training and daily exercises. There are basketball courts, table tennis courts, badminton courts, golf centre, swimming pool (XEC only), fitness centre, archery rooms, fencing rooms, squash courts, billiard rooms, yoga rooms, dance rooms, martial arts rooms, creation rooms, climbing walls, and indoor track. Outdoor sports venues include football pitches, basketball courts, tennis courts, volleyball courts, and so on.

WHAT IS RESEARCH-LED LEARNING?

Sound a bit baffling? Actually, research-led learning isn't that far removed from our daily life. For example, many of you plan to travel with friends to other cities after graduating from high school. The process of planning the trip is actually a kind of research-led learning process.

Generally, you start with web research: What are the attractions in the destination city? What local foods should we try? What's the weather like? How should we travel and where should we stay? And does everyone agree with the plan? In this process, you compare options and read travel reviews, and that's how you exercise your analytical and research skills. Since you're making plans together with friends, your communication and teamwork skills also get a workout. Lastly, you make a decision, and therefore, solve the problem.

After arranging this trip, your planning and communication skills will have improved. And you'll remember this city really well - you'll remember the hotel you chose after comparing multiple options, the transport plan you selected after weighing different routes, and the restaurants you decided on after comparing various places - way more than just a cursory sightseeing trip or quick photo-taking spree.

That's the charm of research-led learning. It comes naturally to you to gain knowledge in order to solve problems. You acquire knowledge rather than accept it. The knowledge you gained through your research sticks with you, and you develop the ability to explore independently.

Unlike the high school mindset of 'accepting knowledge', the university mindset of learning often means 'active exploration'. Here at XJTLU, we're expecting you to gradually develop a research-led mindset, and to shift from high school learning to university learning. Don't worry, at XJTLU this process might be challenging, but it's not painful. HOW TO BECOME A GLOBAL CITIZEN?



VOICES OF EXPERIENCE - LEARNING AT XJTLU



"I have benefited greatly from XJTLU's all-English teaching and research-orientated learning model. I remember a biostatistics class where the professor used the real data of COVID-19 to build a transmission prediction model step by step. Those boring statistical formulas suddenly came to life, allowing me to feel the power of data science in biomedical research for the first time. I deeply realised that the most important value of undergraduate education lies not only in imparting a framework of knowledge, but also in cultivating the ability of continuous learning. In the subsequent laboratory training, the programming skills and statistical methods learnt in the classroom became a solid foundation for me. Faced with emerging new technologies, I gradually developed the learning habit of 'learning by doing'. This shift from passive acceptance of knowledge to active exploration and research has been the most valuable aspects in my growth.

Adapting to all-English academic environment took time. My experience is as follows: familiarise yourself with the courseware before the class, and get to know the field knowledge and related vocabulary; read some supplementary materials to stimulate your interest; the EAP courses for first-year students proved invaluable for developing academic writing and presentation skills. Teachers at XJTLU have office hours, so you can seize the opportunity to communicate with your teachers, read more English papers that you are interested in to broaden the academic horizons as well as to improve your English."

"At XJTLU, the Library and Learning Mall Online (LMO) are two of the study resources I use the most. The library not only has a wide range of books and a comfortable environment, but also offers an extensive range of electronic databases. In the database section, you can search for English papers through WOS, ScienceDirect, and Chinese journals via CNKI and Wan fang Data. If you're preparing for IELTS, the 'Road to IELTS' resource in the library provides a structured system to practice all four skills. When I first joined, I participated in the library's online guide for literature searching, which quickly taught me how to find academic sources and manage references efficiently.

Meanwhile, LMO is the core platform for our daily learning. All course materials, lecture notes, reading lists, assignment instructions, and submissions happen through LMO. It is crucial to check LMO daily, especially if you aim for high grades, keeping up with the latest announcements and coursework requirements is essential. I developed a habit of quickly browsing through my course sections on LMO every morning to catch any updates.



You can try to join one or two clubs that interest you which is very helpful for building friendships. Try to organize and lead some activities. Believe me, this will make you more confident and gain a sense of achievement. If you are interested in scientific research, you can take the initiative to contact the professors of the relevant major. Don't worry that you are new here, every teacher will treat students who are eager to acquire knowledge sincerely and enthusiastically.

In my freshman year, I joined the BPEC which assists our school to implement the Buddy Programme (The only student-driven peer mentorship program among the XJTLU four core education systems). During these two years, my partners and I have jointly built our ideal kingdom both on and off the stage. We have held nearly 15 events of various sizes, putting one idea after another into practice. At the same time, we have also gained precious friendships. During these processes, I explored myself in different fields, learned how to communicate and cooperate more effectively, and grew more determined, inclusive and confident than ever before.

Besides the clubs, I've met many interesting professors and classmates in the Urban Planning programme.

Group Projects: One reason we became familiar with each other so quickly was through working on group projects. Most urban planning courses require teamwork. For example, when I took UPD106 in my second year, every tutorial involved group brainstorming sessions where we created posters on the spot and then gave random group presentations. Group assignments came in different formats too: UPD106 ended with a group debate, UPD209 required site visits followed by group presentations, and UPD206 involved writing an analytical prediction report based on government website data.

What I Gained from Group Work: Working with different people taught me to approach problems from multiple perspectives. Of course, different ways of thinking also meant we had to learn to accommodate and understand each other. Group work gave us a taste of what it's like to interact with all kinds of people in the real world. In my experience, the key is staying open-minded and willing to communicate. You have to accept that "sometimes others will convince me, and sometimes I will convince others." Communication encourages you to rethink conclusions from different viewpoints and to reason things out by standing in someone else's shoes. That's the true beauty of group work.

Finding a Sense of Belonging: Urban Planning is a very tight-knit department, thanks in large part to the many activities organised each semester, like badminton tournaments and New Year parties. Students from all year levels take part — and so do the professors, who chat and play games with everyone. Our Development Advisor (DA) also cares a lot about student life. During midterms and finals, they often organise relaxation parties in the little garden on the third floor of the EB building, offering snacks to help us de-stress. These events are usually announced in the class group chat, so it's important to keep an eye on it to stay updated about what's happening in the department.

VOICES OF EXPERIENCE - FUTURE PLANNING



“At XJTLU, finding your own direction without external pressure is especially important. Unlike traditional universities, XJTLU does not offer clear short-term or long-term goals such as guaranteed postgraduate study opportunities or standardised English tests like CET-4 and CET-6. As a result, some students may fall into a ‘boiling frog’ situation—unaware that they are falling behind in their studies or internship preparation due to a lack of urgency.

My approach is to start by imagining the kind of life I want in the future, and then gradually refine my goals. For example, I would ask myself what kind of work mode I prefer: do I like having tasks assigned by a supervisor, or do I prefer planning things independently? Based on these preferences, I would explore suitable careers and look into the specific lifestyle and responsibilities involved - such as daily working hours or whether frequent travel is required.

However, many freshmen may find it difficult to envision a future career due to a lack of experience. That’s why connecting with senior students and expanding your network is a crucial way to gather real-world information.

Lastly, trying different things is essential. Often, our assumptions about a certain career - or others’ descriptions of an ‘ideal job’ - may not be entirely accurate. Only through hands-on experience can you truly determine what suits you. In my second year, I participated in several research projects. Through those experiences, I discovered a strong passion for research and realised it was a perfect fit for me. That eventually led me to pursue a career in academia, and I’ve stayed committed to that path through to the PhD level.”

FRESHMEN TASKS

Dear Students

Welcome to Xi’an Jiaotong-Liverpool University (XJTLU) family.

To help you transit smoothly into university life, we have specially designed a series of task checklists. By completing these tasks, you will gradually familiarise yourself with our campus culture, build a sense of belonging, and acquire essential survival skills.

PRE-ARRIVAL CHECKLIST (FROM ADMISSION TO REGISTRATION)

- 01 **Activate and use your XJTLU email account.** All important notifications from the university, including those about registration, course selection, and timetables, will be sent to your mailbox. Please check it daily to stay informed and avoid missing any critical updates.
- 02 **Carefully read the 2025 - 2026 New Student Registration Guide.** Pay particular attention to key processes such as tuition payment and on-site registration. Ensure that all required steps are completed within the designated time frame.
- 03 **Log in and explore the e-Bridge platform.** Before proceeding with academic year registration and course selection, please carefully read the ‘2025-2026 Freshman Major Selection Guide’ and ‘the Academic Registration Guide’ to understand prerequisite courses and requirements for various programs. This will help you clarify your intended major and make informed decisions about elective courses aligned with your personal development plan. Subsequently, complete your academic year registration via the e-Bridge platform. Follow instructions in the emails from the Academic Timetables Team (timetables@xjtlu.edu.cn) to select courses via the Timetable Plus system.
- 04 **Familiarise yourself with the services of university departments.** Review resources such as CHASING YOUR DREAM and the university’s official website to learn about the service offerings and contact details of various administrative departments. Develop the ability to proactively seek out campus resources and support systems.
- 05 **Connect with your Buddy.** The university assigns each new student a senior student Buddy to help you adapt to campus life. Before the semester begins, join the official local Buddy QQ group from your hometown to interact with local Buddies and fellow incoming students in advance. During Week 0, proactively contact your assigned class Buddy by checking your email to receive timely assistance.
- 06 **Establish contact with your Development Advisor (DA).** This marks a crucial starting point for your university journey. Access your DA’s information via the e-Bridge platform, join your administrative class group before Week 0, and check your email for notifications about the first class meeting.

The Post-Arrival Growth Checklist and detailed instructions will be announced after registration.

A SPECIAL NOTE FOR NEW STUDENTS

Dear students, these tasks are not ‘assessments’ but an ‘action map’ we have designed for you. Like newbie quests in a game, they will guide you to unlock essential skills and growth pathways for university life.
