Minimum Requirements for Being “Research Active”

The term "Research Active" typically refers to academic staff who are actively engaged in research activities within their primary and secondary research fields, at least in terms of the following aspects:

a) Research Publications

Academic staff should regularly publish research findings in academic journals, conferences, and other research platforms.

Academic staff should produce at least 2 research outputs within 3 years, or 3 outputs within 5 years, with relevant publications ranked in JCR Q3 journals or above, or C2 peer-reviewed conference proceedings or above. For at least 1 paper, the staff should be one of the main contributors.

b) Research Collaboration

Academic staff should actively participate in interdisciplinary or cross-institutional research by collaborating on joint research projects with other schools/academies in XJTLU, other universities, academic institutions, industries, or international organizations. Academic staff should engage in scholarly exchange, and present research findings by actively attending academic conferences. Academic staff should give at least one talk per year at a reputable academic institute or conference.
